Duty Location, TBD: Rapid City, SD / Sioux Falls, SD

Lowest/Highest AGR Grade to Apply: O4-O5

Start Date: 12 August 2024

General Eligibility Requirements: For initial eligibility of a position, individual must meet the minimum grade to apply. Must live within 50 miles of duty location upon assignment to the position. This announcement does not constitute a commitment to fill the position. Selection may include additional travel requirements to support TAG's schedule. This tour is a Nominative Position. Selecting Official will only interview the top applications.

Minimum Eligibility Requirements: Must meet the medical fitness standards for retention IAW AR 40-501. Soldiers must meet the physical requirements IAW AR 600-9. Must meet eligibility requirements IAW AR 600-8-2. Ineligible flags include, but are not limited to adverse, ACFT, Ht/Wt, and security violations. Meet additional qualification requirements outlined in NGR 600-5, AR 135-18 and other applicable regulations and laws governing the Active Guard/Reserve Program. TS/SCI will be required if selected.

Duty Description: Responsible for monitoring the day-to-day activities of TAG, along with planning for the short and long-range events TAG will participate in. Primary duties include coordinating office calls/meetings; organizing travel and training; overseeing protocol for Guard events and correspondence; planning and conducting special events; conducting and/or coordinating research; maintaining TAG assigned equipment. Serves as the Congressional Action Coordination Officer and POC for SD Congressional Delegation (CODEL), both state and federal.

Special Information: The South Dakota National Guard does not discriminate in employment on the basis of race, color, religion, sex (including pregnancy and gender), national origin, political affiliation, sexual orientation, marital status, retaliation, parental status, or other non-merit factor. Selection will be made from the applicants determined best qualified in terms principally involving experience, demonstrated ability/performance, and training. Applicants may be subject to personal interview upon notification of time and place. Necessary travel is at applicant's own expense. Inquiries concerning specific aspects of the duty position should be directed to the nominating official.
